Draft K-6 Curriculum


Trustees approved a recommendation to urge the Minister of Education to consider extending the current timeline for the implementation of the Draft K–6 Curriculum, and furthermore, to also urge the Minister of Education to consider rewriting the Draft K–6 Curriculum before integrating curriculum content.

Trustees approved the <u>Board Legacy Document</u> (2017–2021).
