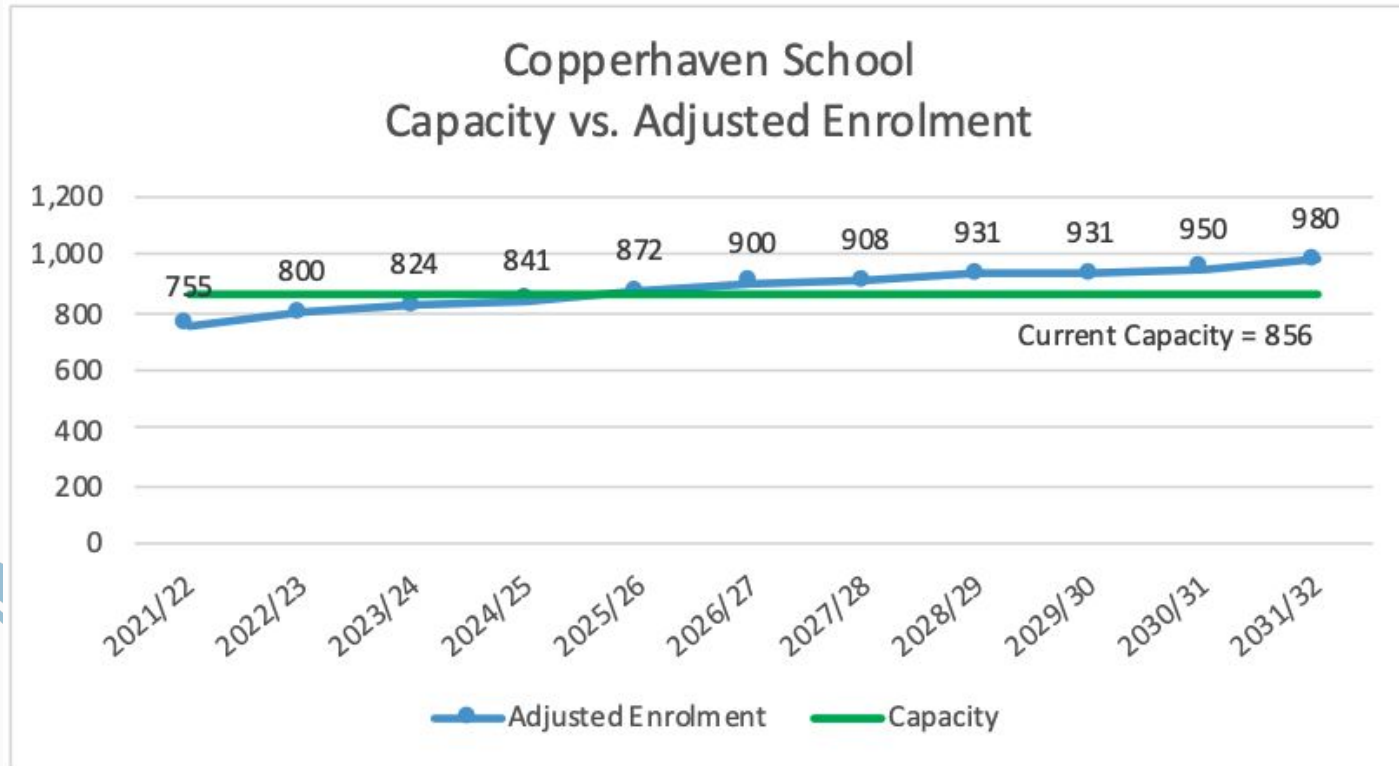

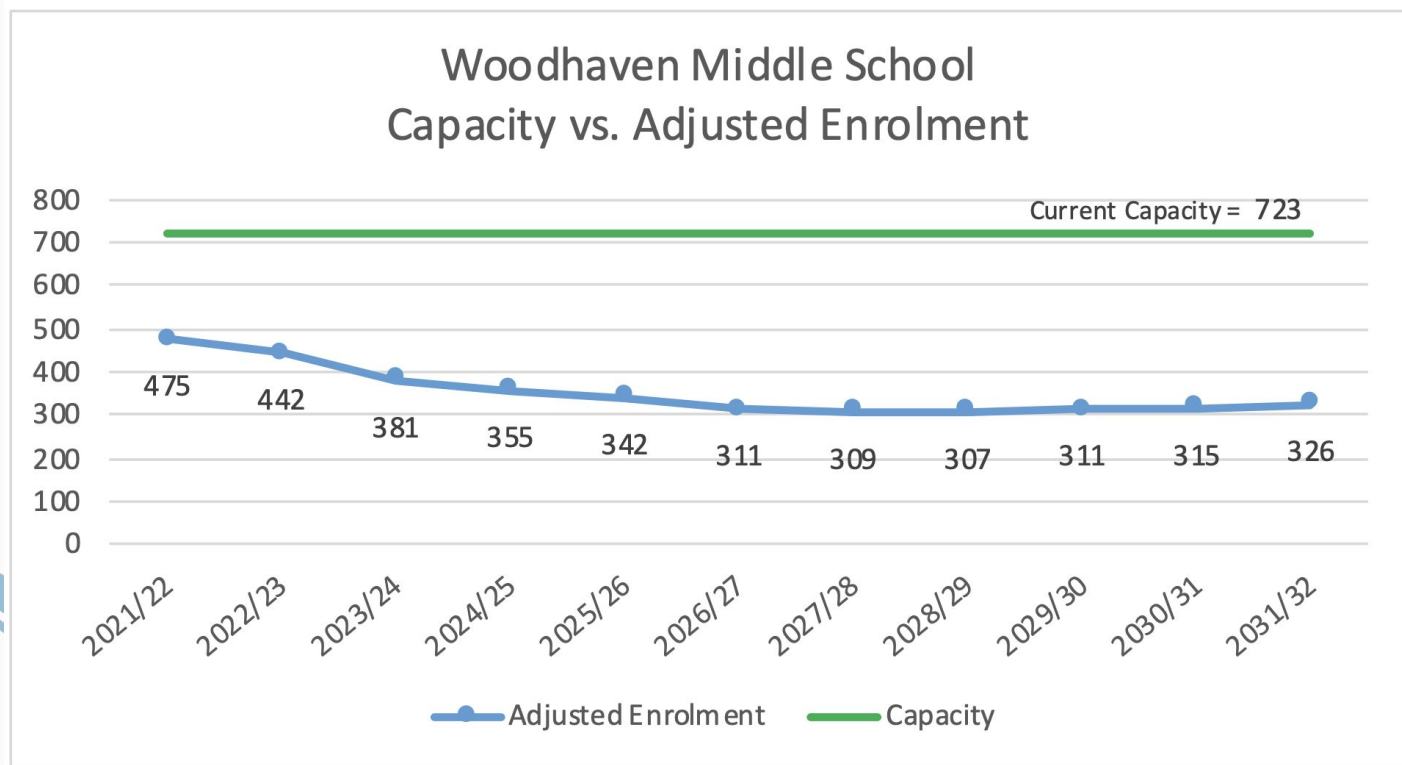

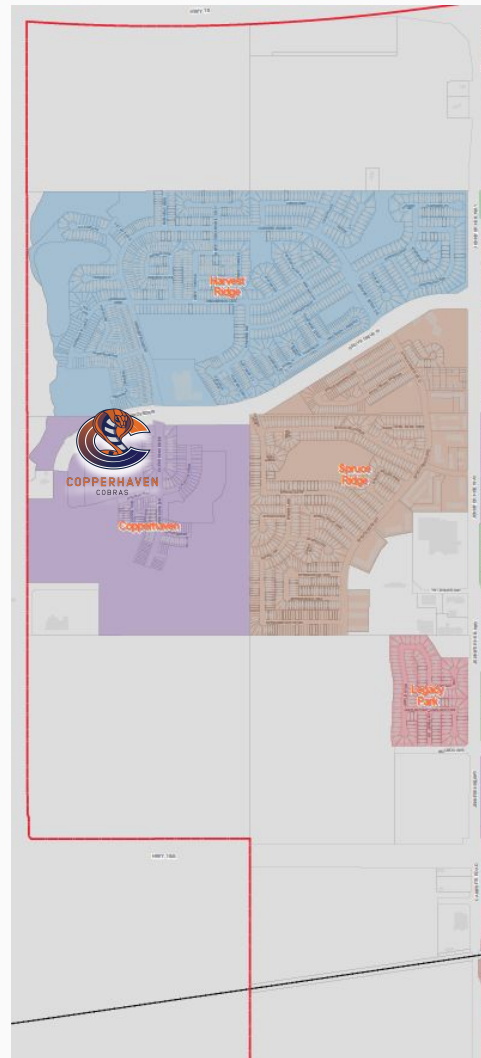


# Rationale:
