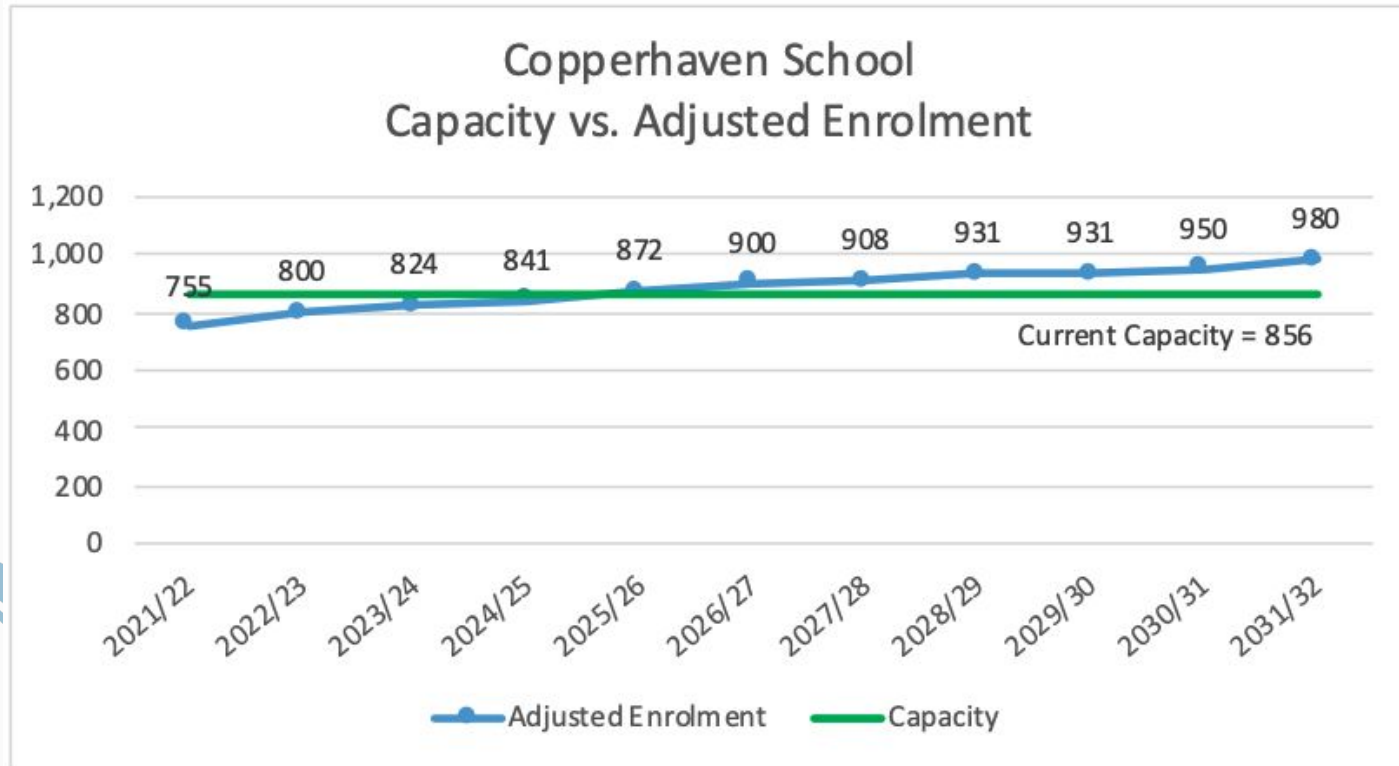

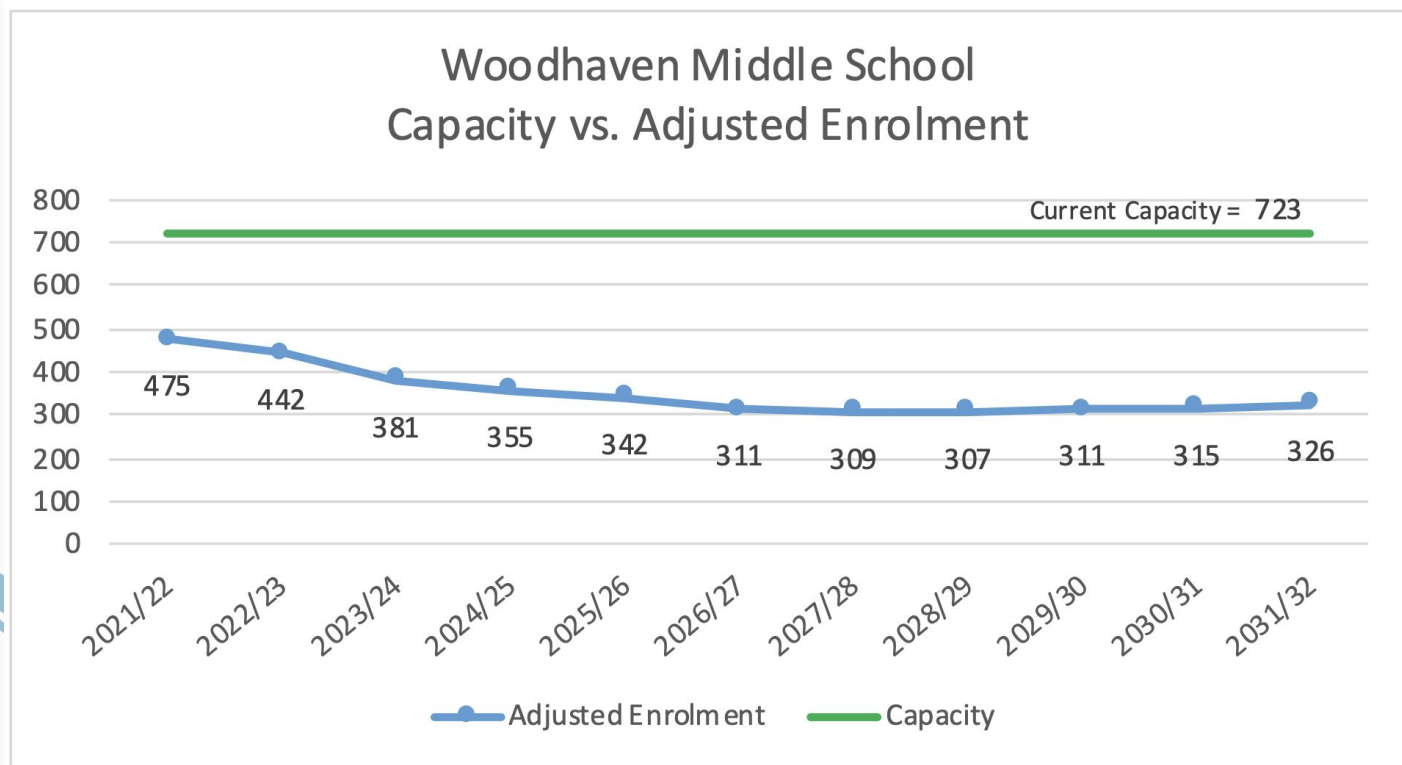

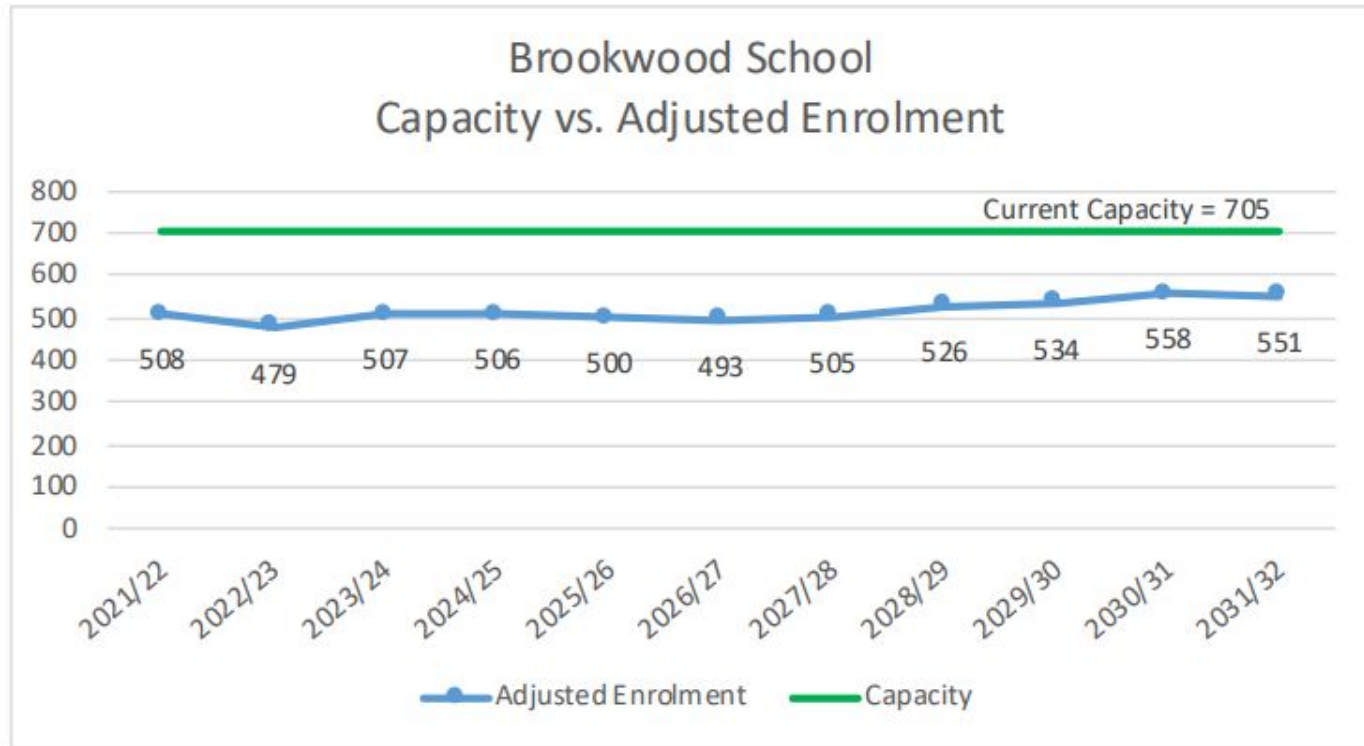
Woodhaven Middle School: Projected Enrolment

- Continue monitoring growth in West Central and Shiloh. These include the existing neighbourhoods of Legacy Park and the area west and southwest of Walmart on Campsite Road. Predesignate these areas to Brookwood and Woodhaven. Addition of 2-3 modular units

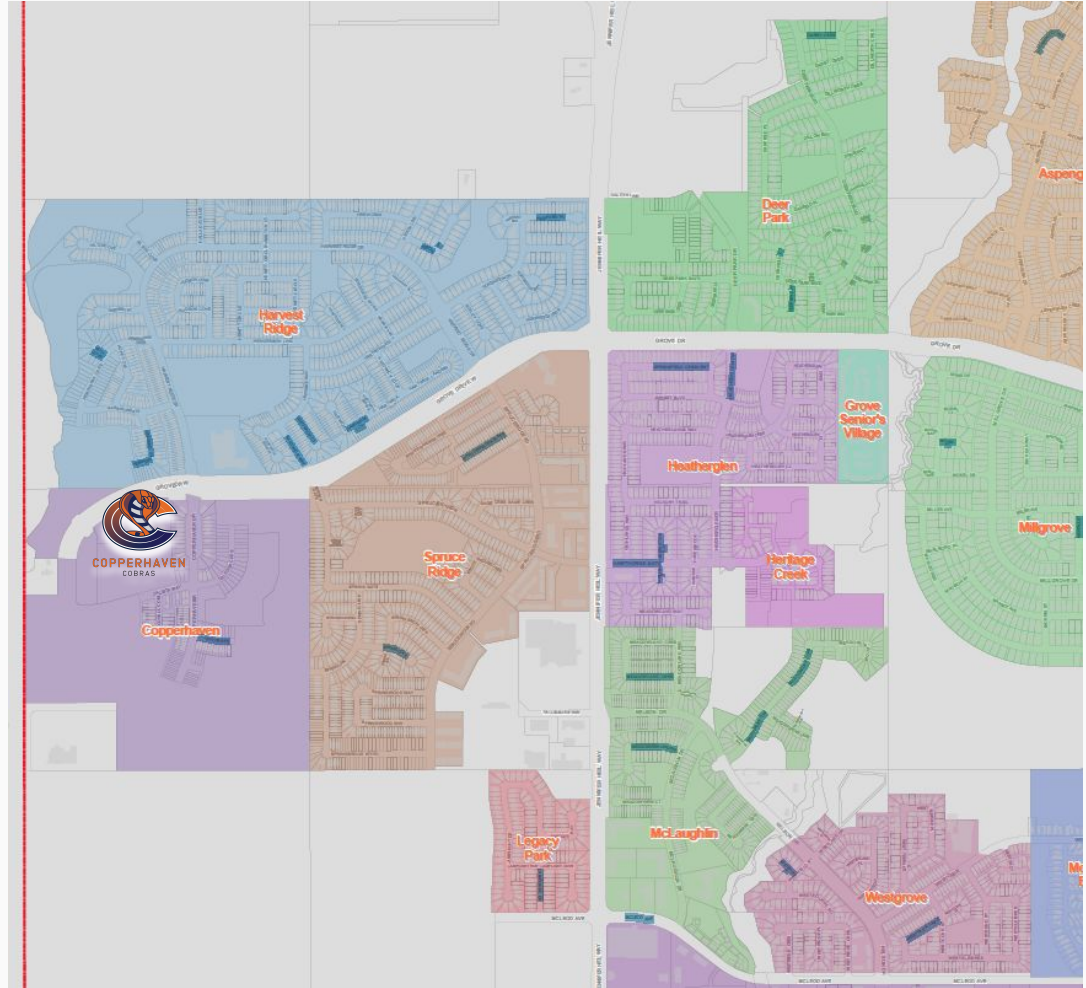


Rationale:

- Increases utilization rate of Woodhaven and Brookwood School

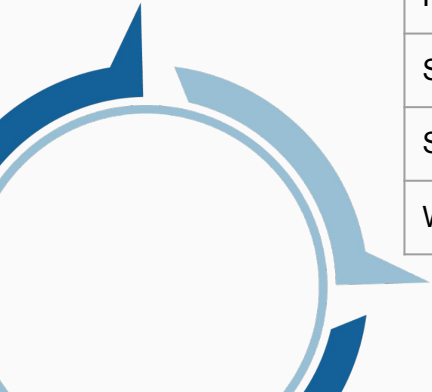


City of Spruce Grove West End
