In a decisive move, Trustees unanimously passed a recommendation addressing the complications surrounding the construction of the new \$100 million Spruce Grove Composite High School.

Quarterly Financial Report

The Board approved the **Quarterly Financial** Report (Q3).

As of May 31, 2024:

- Revenues year-to-date were \$119.8 million.
- Expenditures year-to-date were \$117.5 million.
- The result was a surplus of \$2.3 million.

A surplus of \$2.4 million is forecast for the year ending August 31, 2024. Approximately \$1.8 million will be transferred to capital to support projects this year and in future years. The Division is projecting an operating reserve of \$5.0 million (before School Generated Funds).

Organizational Meeting

Prior to the Regular Board meeting, Trustees hosted their Organizational meeting for the 2024-2025 school year. By acclamation, the Board re-elected Trustee Lorraine Stewart (Ward 2) as Board Chair and elected Aimee Hennig (Ward 3) as Vice-Chair. The oath of office will take place at the Board meeting in September.

The Board also organized for the upcoming school year by approving **Board Remuneration**, Meeting Dates and the Board Annual Work Plan for 2024-2025.
