PARKLAND SCHOOL DIVISION

This form is established under the authority of the Government of Alberta's Fairness and Safety in Sport Act, the Fairness and Safety in Sport Regulation, and Parkland School Division's Administrative Procedure 178 – Athlete Eligibility in Female-Only School Sports. Once completed, the form can be submitted to AthleteEligibility@psd.ca for review and adjudication.

Purpose of the Challenge Process

The challenge process exists to ensure that athlete eligibility requirements are applied fairly and consistently, and to uphold the integrity of female-only athletics within School Sport Albertasanctioned competitions. It provides a formal mechanism for addressing concerns in a manner that is respectful, confidential, and compliant with legislation.

Eligibility to Submit a Challenge

Only the following individuals may submit a challenge:

- A student athlete who is 18 years of age or older and engaged in the relevant sport, class, or division;
- The parent or legal guardian of a student athlete engaged in the relevant sport, class, or division; or
- The principal of an Alberta school with a team participating in the same relevant sport, class, or division.
