Explore the opportunities yoga can provide with physical movement and emotional regulation in a welcoming environment. For children ages 5-12 years old, along with their caregivers.



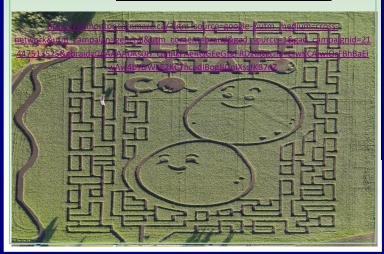
